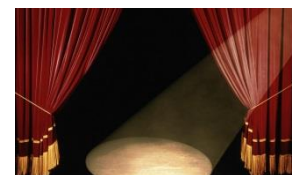
athletics and AJ achieved gold for rounders. All the pupils were fabulous ambassadors for Stafford and behaved brilliantly.
