Message from the Headteacher



Dear Parents and Carers,

The weather has taken a definite wintery turn this week and we have sent you details via email of how we will communicate with you if we ever have to make the decision to close either school due to adverse weather or any other emergency. In addition to updating the school website, local radio stations and the Federation Facebook page, the method for informing parents directly of a school closure is via text message. Please ensure that you have notified us of any changes to your mobile number or email address to ensure any messages we send reach you successfully. We will always aim to keep both schools open unless it would be unsafe to do so.

Administering Medicines



Please note only medication prescribed by a Doctor will be administered. Parents will be responsible for obtaining their child's medicine and ensuring these are up to date. Medication must not be brought into school by the child. The parent must hand all medication to a member of the office staff and complete the necessary forms.

Medicines should always be provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and include the prescriber's instructions. In all cases it is necessary to check that written details include;

- **Child's name**
- **Name of the medicine**
- **Dose**
- **Method of administration**
- **Time/frequency of administration**
- **Any possible side affects**
- **Expiry date**

Non-prescribed medicines will NOT be administered to pupils unless advised by the medical practitioner, Parents however are welcome to come into school to administer medicines such as Calpol or paracetamol.

Year 6 SATs – Information

A reminder for parents and carers of Year 6 that we would like to invite you into school, next Wednesday 18th January at 5:30pm, to share information with you about the statutory assessments that your child will sit in May this year and how we are preparing the children for these assessments. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions and also find out how you can support your child at home. We look forward to seeing you at the meeting.
