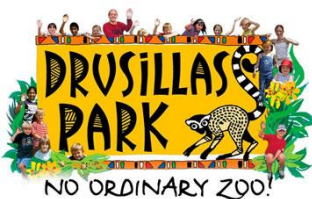


## Federation Family Camp, 10 July - Save the Date!
