Exciting Baby News

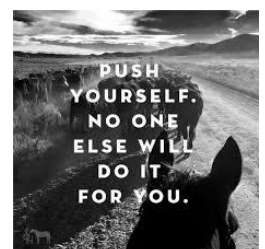
