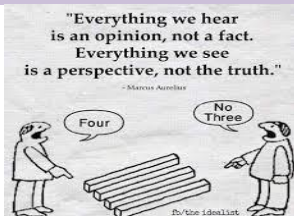


Stafford Disco needs volunteers on 15th February

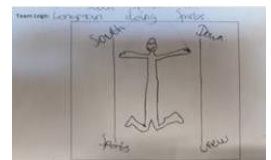


Thoughts for the week : Perspective and Approach Isobel's Logo
